

Questions to ask the writer before providing feedback

- 1. Ask the writer what stage this piece is at: rough draft, draft, revision, nearly finished, etc.
- 2. Ask the writer who their intended audience is
- 3. Ask the writer what they would like to do with the piece in the future

Questions to answer as part of your feedback

Always be courteous and constructive.

- From your perspective as the reader, what is this piece of writing trying to accomplish?
- In what ways does it succeed? (For example, "I feel like I am there in the room with the narrator.")
- What specific aspects of this piece make it succeed (wording, imagery, plot, tone, etc.)?
- What parts/elements/aspects of this piece do not resonate with you as a reader and why?
- How do you think those parts/elements/aspects could be strengthened?
- Is there any part of this piece that should be edited out and perhaps saved for a different project?
